### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

Under the direct supervision of the Lead Operator, the Water/Wastewater Operator is responsible for all activities related, but not limited to: Drytown and New Post Public Drinking Water systems, SBR (main) Wastewater Treatment Plant, Reserve Lagoon wastewater treatment, and New Post Sand Filter wastewater plant.

# **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- WI DNR Water License
- Valid Driver's License
- High School Diploma
- Maintains ongoing education with direction from Indian Health Service.
- Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen and random drug screens thereafter.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Performs regular inspections: including daily checks of community water supplies, facilities and equipment.
- Operates and maintains equipment including: trucks, tractors, Kubota, jetter, pressure washers, mowers, brushers, generators, etc.
- Monitors and operates all electronic controls and equipment to all pump houses and lift stations.
- Assists in bi-annual flushing of hydrants for proper operation.
- Maintains the pump houses to ensure safety, shoveling, painting, etc.
- Works, on occasions longer hours as necessary for emergency responses or repairs.
- Responds to emergency calls.
- Perform routine office housekeeping such as cleaning and painting.
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Public Works.
