

Lac Courte Oreilles Identification Card Information

Boozhoo,

A completed identification (ID) application form is required for the issuance of a Lac Courte Oreilles tribal identification card through the communication platform called "ZOOM". This method of obtaining an ID card is reserved for individuals who live at a distance from Lac Courte Oreilles or individuals who have mobility issues. Others may qualify for obtaining an ID through this method based on other factors after consultation and approval by the Enrollment Department. Please contact the Department for more details and information.

Please complete the ID application form by providing answers to all applicable questions. In addition, use black ink, and make sure to sign the application **within** the designated box at the bottom of the form. This signature is included on the ID card.

Send the completed application with the \$6.00 application fee (in cash or money order made out to Lac Courte Oreilles Tribal Government) to:

After the application and fee is received, members will be contacted regarding further details including a date and time for the ZOOM ID appointment. Please make sure to include a current phone number on the application.

Note that individuals requesting an ID through ZOOM should be familiar with the ZOOM app and have it installed on a smartphone. Because of the specific requirements for creating an ID through this platform, it is important that individuals have the ability to be mobile for proper lighting and background requirements. In particular, it's important to not have any shadows on an individual's face and to also have a background that is plain (preferably light blue and without a pattern). The use of a desktop computer is not recommended. Assistance from other individuals is also encouraged.

After the ID card is processed, it will be sent to the mailing address listed on the application form. Note that the "street address" is the address that will be printed on the ID card.
