- Admission to practice law by the WI Supreme Court prior to start date.
- General knowledge of Federal Indian law with emphasis on applicable current federal and state case law, statutes and regulations relating to Indian tribes is beneficial but not mandatory.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills; must work effectively with other people at a variety of ages and levels, competency in various computer programs, and able to work independently to get a project completed.
- Proficiency in legal research techniques, electronic research skills, and knowledge of legal and other resources.
- Ability to identify and analyze legal issues and present legal theories.
- Independent and organized and able to manage significant number of matters simultaneously.
- Professional demeanor and appearance; and demonstrated ability to meet deadlines in fast-paced environment.
- Well-developed interpersonal skills and ability to work in a supportive and professional manner with other attorneys, support staff and client agencies.
