Position Overview

Honor the Earth is seeking reliable, professional Security Staff to support the safety and well-being of participants during the upcoming weekend celebration. Security team members will help maintain a respectful and welcoming environment, monitor event grounds, and respond appropriately to safety concerns.

Responsibilities

- Monitor designated areas of the event grounds and provide a visible security presence
- Support crowd management and ensure safe movement of attendees
- Assist with entry/exit points, including basic access control
- Identify and respond to safety or medical concerns and notify supervisors as needed
- Communicate effectively with event organizers, volunteers, and emergency personnel
- Provide clear, calm de-escalation when needed
- Document incidents and follow event protocols
- Uphold a respectful and culturally aware presence at all times

Qualifications

- Prior security, event staff, or public safety experience preferred but not required
- Ability to remain calm and professional in fast-paced environments
- Strong communication and problem-solving skills
- Dependable, punctual, and able to work a full 24-hour weekend schedule
- Must be 18 years or older
- Must be able to stand, walk, and be outdoors for extended periods
