DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Directly responsible to K-12 Principal.
- To implement skills and knowledge in one or more courses in auto mechanics, electricity, power mechanics or general shop to Middle and High School Students.
- Responsible for record keeping (attendance, grades, reports, etc.)
- Communicate with parents regarding progress.
- To develop in each pupil an insight and understanding of industry, business and professional conduct.
- To develop practical problem solving skills related to the materials and process of industry.
- To develop in each pupil skills in the safe use of tools and machines, use of eye protection and safety guards.
- Guide pupils in selection of appropriate projects.

- Supervises students in out of class activities as assigned.
- In corporate culture based curriculum/lesson plans for the instruction of aforementioned courses.

- Responsible for orderly classroom and clean-up activities accomplished within the allotted time.
- Attend weekly staff meetings and on a voluntary basis, School Board meeting.
- Assists in school events such as, but not limited to; school powwows, assemblies and graduations.
